Armellini Express Lines Upgrades Oxnard Facility Coolers and Dock.

New cooler enhancements means better temperatures for incoming shipments

Oxnard, CA, December 22, 2011: Armellini Express Lines has invested in major enhancements at their Oxnard, CA cooler facility in order to improve temperature control and power consumption efficiency. The changes to the facility are intended to keep incoming shipments at optimum shipping temperature ranges.

Resealed Dock Doors-Dock doors have been resealed to prevent the escaping of refrigerated air. The company has seen lower power consumption and better temperature consistency as a result of this change.

Installation of Additional Air-Handlers-Air handlers have been added to increase air-circulation around the cooler. Every cubic foot of cold space is at a consistent temperature.

New Insulation-Old insulation was removed and new insulation installed. This new insulation carries a higher rating and has resulted in better temperature management and less power consumption.

Upgraded Lighting-New lighting was added throughout the cooler. This new lighting is much more energy efficient than the previous system. New lights are brighter making

working conditions easier. The new system runs much colder than the older lighting grid in the building, again consuming less energy.

In summary, Armellini Express Lines has heavily invested in the quality of temperature stability, while reducing its carbon footprint in Oxnard, CA by installing additional air-handlers, re-insulating the entire cooler, replacing and repairing dock door seals and upgrading lighting.
